Privacy Policy

Forest Enterprises is committed to protecting your personal information. We have developed this Privacy Policy to help you understand how and why we collect information from you, how we store it, how you can access and correct that information and when we might disclose information to other people.

This Privacy Policy does not limit or exclude your rights under the Privacy Act 1993.

Application of this Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy applies to all instances where we collect information about you.

Consent to the collection of your personal information

By accessing Forest Enterprises' website, contacting Forest Enterprises and/or becoming a client or investor of Forest Enterprises services or investments, you consent to the collection, use, disclosure, storage and processing of your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Collection of your personal information

We will collect personal information submitted by you through our website, any communication with Forest Enterprises directly via writing, phone or email and information obtained through our services. We may supplement the information you provide us with information we receive from third parties.

Personal information we may collect

We may, in addition to other information, collect the following information about you:

- Your name, email address, residential address, telephone number, and date and place of birth.
- Preference information such as investment and marketing preferences.
- Information that you provide to us when we communicate via writing, email or phone.
- Information obtained from third parties in accordance with this Privacy Policy.
- Other additional information required from time to time.

In addition, if you invest with us or use our services, we may collect information such as your bank account number and other financial information from you.

Some of this information is required by law, for example it must be provided as part of customer due diligence under the Anti-Money Laundering and Countering Financing of Terrorism Act 2009. Or it may be required under the Limited Partnerships Act 2008, if you invest in one of our limited partnerships. Therefore, if you choose not to provide information when we ask for it, you may not be able to invest with Forest Enterprises.

Use of your personal information

The information that we collect from you may be used for a number of purposes relating to our business, which include:

- Provide you with information about us, our products and services and new investment opportunities that we think may be of interest to you.
- To meet our statutory and other legal obligations with respect to our services and investments.
- Performing the services and any support required in connection with our services and investments.
- To satisfy our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us.
- To contact you to ensure customer satisfaction in respect of our role as the service provider or investment manager.
- Responding and following up on any queries, complaints or requests you might have made, and other customer care issues.
- To monitor, improve and administer our services and our website.



You also consent to Forest Enterprises collecting, using and disclosing your personal information for the following purposes:

- Verifying any information that you give to us (or information that we may collect from other sources) with third parties and third party databases, including Government agencies
- Carrying out checks on you for the purposes of the Anti-Money Laundering and Countering of Financing Terrorism Act 2009
- Verifying any information that you give to us (or information that we may collect from other sources) with third parties and third party databases for the purposes of fraud prevention or legal compliance

You authorise any third party to provide your personal information to us for any of these purposes.

Protecting your personal information

We will take reasonable steps to ensure that the personal information that we collect, use or disclose is accurate, complete, up-to-date and stored in a secure environment protected from unauthorised access, modification or disclosure.

Retention of your personal information

We will hold your personal information but only for so long as we are lawfully entitled to do so.

Sharing your personal information

We will keep confidential all personal information collected about you. The only exceptions to this are:

- The disclosure relates to the purpose for which the information was collected.
- You have provided us with express consent to disclose your personal information.
- We may disclose certain personal information about you to third-party service providers in the course of their provision of services to us. We will take reasonable steps to ensure that these service providers are obligated to keep confidential any of your personal information that they receive and use.
- Any person or organisation authorised by the Privacy Act 1993.
- Persons or organisations to whom we may be required to pass on your personal information for the purposes of complying with any legal, governmental or regulatory requirement on us or in connection with legal proceedings, crime or fraud prevention, detection or prosecution.
